**VARIANCE REQUEST: INTERIM**

**TERM OF REQUEST: DECEMBER 12, 2025 TO REGULAR VARIANCE HEARING**

Petitioner seeks relief from the annual source test permit conditions for one flare and four internal combustion engines (permits GNR-0017569, 14976A, GNR-0017570, GNR-0017042, and GNR-0017043) and the annual source test requirement in Title 17 CCR § 95463(b)(4). A series of issues arose since July 2025 that made source testing or normal operation of devices not possible. Primarily, the engines could not be source tested due to ground faulting instability which prevents synchronization with the utility grid. To date, engine operation and source tests are subject to 3<sup>rd</sup> party, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, repairs and flare zone A source test are subject to 3<sup>rd</sup> party, Blue Sky Environmental, testing schedule availability. The interim and regular variance is needed to allow time for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to make repairs to their equipment so the engines can become operable and subsequently schedule the source tests. The flare zone A source test is tentatively scheduled for December 10, 2025.
