To: ORVR Fleet Facilities and Gasoline Dispensing Facility Installation, Repair and Testing Contractors

RE: Approaching Deadline for Installation of Low Permeation Hoses at ORVR Fleet Facilities

Gasoline dispensing facilities operating in the Monterey Bay Air Resources District's jurisdiction with an onboard refueling vapor recovery (ORVR) Fleet exemption from Phase II vapor recovery requirements must upgrade their gasoline dispensing hoses. Conventional gasoline dispensing hoses must be replaced with *low permeation* conventional gasoline dispensing hoses by June 10, 2018. Only hoses certified by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and listed in <u>Executive Order NVR-1-B</u> may be installed. Please note this advisory does not apply to equipment storing and dispensing diesel fuel.

ORVR Fleet facilities observed operating after June 10, 2018 with conventional gasoline dispensing hoses may be subject to enforcement action.
