SCHOOL BUS TYPE FOR LESBP APPLICATIONS.

School bus types C and D are larger school buses, as defined in the *1995 National Standards for School Transportation (CMSU)*. Type C and D school buses carry more than ten persons, including the driver, and have gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of over 10,000 pounds [4,536 kg]. All school buses must be 40' [12.1 m] or less in length, and 8.5' [2.6 m] or less in width. To be eligible for replacement under LESBP, a bus must have a GVWR of over 14,000 lbs.

Type C School Bus

A "Conventional" bus, with the engine located in *front of the windshield* and under a *projecting nose or cowl*. The entrance door is *behind* the front wheels.

Type D School Bus

This is the *flat-nosed transit-style school bus*. The entrance door is located *ahead* of the front wheels. The engine may be located anywhere, as long as it is *behind* the windshield.

Type SE or Special Ed School bus.

These buses have a wheelchair lift.
